

Course details

Foundation Advanced course is offered to students who successfully complete the Foundation Basic course at BT. Foundation Advanced course helps students build on the concepts of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Logic, Coding which they have learned during the Basic course. Foundation Advanced course will ensure that students raise their level in these subjects and build on the momentum that they are carrying from the Foundation Basic course.

Like Foundation Basic, we shall teach Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Logic & Coding in Foundation Advanced course too. Biology is offered as an additional optional subject in Foundation Advanced course just like it was offered in the Foundation Basic course.

2 lectures per week shall be offered in the Foundation Advanced course. Each lecture shall be of 3 hours & 20 mins duration, with a 15 mins break in between. In addition to these 2 lectures per week, a few special lectures will also be conducted for **preparation of important exams like Dr. Homi Bhabha, NSEJS and IOQM** etc.

Course formats

Foundation Advanced course formats:

The Foundation Advanced course is offered in 3 formats:

- 1. Foundation Advanced Offline (Completely offline)
- 2. Foundation Advanced Synergy (Offline + Online)
- 3. Foundation Advanced Online (Completely online)

1. Foundation Advanced Offline:

In this format, both the lectures per week will be conducted in classroom coaching mode (offline mode). The student can choose a center of his/her choice (out of the options available in this format in his/her merit-wise category).

2. Foundation Advanced Synergy:

In this format, every week, 1 lecture shall be conducted in classroom coaching mode at our various centers and 1 lecture shall be conducted in online mode. Online lectures are live lectures as per the batch timing, which the students can attend from the comfort of their homes. For classroom lectures, student can choose a center of his/her choice (out of the options available in this format in his merit-wise category).

3. Foundation Advanced online:

In this format, students shall attend both lectures per week online. At BT, the online lectures are live and also lively where students participate via chat and by un-muting themselves responsibly.

If students wish, they will be allowed to shift from one format to another at any time during the course, based on seat availability.

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Course material & online testing platform

BT provides its own course material and recommends a few books for additional study which the student needs to arrange. It also provides an online testing platform which is used to conduct various practice tests and online BTests. This Online platform provides a detailed & personalised analysis of the student's performance like time spent to solve each question, subject wise comparison with toppers, topic wise strength & weaknesses etc. giving vital inputs for improvement in the examination technique.

Students opting for Completely offline or synergy format will be requested to collect the study material from their nearest BT center in Pune. Students opting for a completely online format will get the study material via courier free of cost (within India). Overseas students will be expected to bear the courier charges.

Doubt clearing platforms

Apart from doubts discussed during the lecture, there will be various ways through which students can get their doubts cleared. Following are the platforms which students can use for the same:

1. 20 mins reserved for doubts after each lecture:

In addition to the doubts discussed during the lecture, each 3 hour lecture will be followed by a 20 mins doubt session. In these 20 mins, teachers will be available for doubt discussion (both in online and offline lecture). Students can make use of this extra time to interact with teachers personally and get their doubts solved.

2. Availability of teachers for doubts at centers for entire day:

At all centers, teachers dedicated for doubts are available throughout the day where students can discuss their doubts personally with them on a one-to-one basis.

3. Online doubt sessions:

In addition to the regular weekly lectures, we shall also conduct online doubt sessions daily where students can interact with the teacher and get his/her doubts cleared.

4. Doubt Forum:

Bakliwal Tutorials has an interactive doubt forum with exciting features where students can post their doubts and also solve the doubts of other students. Teachers also provide detailed video solutions of the doubts in the forum. The questions are easily searchable and are systematically available for reference and learning. Despite being a closed forum, meant exclusively for BT students, BT's doubt forum is amongst the top results in Google search.

5. Telegram Group:

Official Telegram groups (similar to WhatsApp groups) are created batch-wise with the sole purpose of doubts discussion. Students can post their doubts in that group and fellow batch mates along with teachers will participate to solve the same. This helps students to get instant solutions to most of their doubts at almost any time of the day.

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Online Interaction with students & parents

In order to guide the students and parents about the Foundation Advanced course and answer their queries, the following session is planned for them:

Date - 12th January 2025 (Sunday)

6:00 to 7:30 pm: Logic revision lecture for students by Vaibhav Bakliwal Sir

7:45 to 9:00 pm: Q & A session for parents & students about the Foundation Advanced course

Admission Process

Admission to the Foundation Advanced course will be based on the student's performance in the 4 BTests conducted during the Foundation Basic course till date. The following weights will be assigned to each BTest performance:

- ☐ BTest 1 20% weightage
- ☐ BTest 2 20% weightage
- ☐ BTest 3 20% weightage
- ☐ BTest 4 40% weightage

In case you were absent for any of these tests, the score for the absent test will be assumed to be the minimum score amongst all the tests for which you were present.

Note that a separate list of students who gave the BTests online and offline will be compiled and the available seats (and scholarships and batches as well) will be split amongst offline and online students in proportion to their total numbers.

For now, all the students of the Foundation Basic course will be asked to fill up a **Batch Preference Form** (for their choice of slot for the Refresher Program & offline/online batches after the Refresher Program get over). The details about the Refresher Program is mentioned ahead in the leaflet.

Based on merit, only selected Foundation Basic students will be offered this course. To start with, top students will be offered the Wizards batch and next set of students will be offered COC and Champion batches for the Refresher Program.

The students will be informed about their selection for this course, on **16th January 2025 (Thursday)** via email. These students need to complete the admission formalities for the Foundation Advanced course latest by **26th January, 2025 (Sunday)**. After 26th January, a few waitlisted students may be offered the admission depending upon the seats availability.

For students who do not qualify for the Foundation Advanced course for now, we shall conduct an **Online Camp** (free of cost) for them in the month of April (details of the same are mentioned ahead in this leaflet).

Start date of the course

The Foundation Advanced Course will begin during the week starting from May 5th, 2025.

However, there will be a 'Refresher Program' in the month of March/April 2025, the details of which are given below.

Details about the Refresher Program

In this Refresher Program, we shall conduct a quick revision of the Foundation Basic course for the Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics subjects.

The Refresher Program will be conducted in 2 slots:

Slot 1

Date: 24th March to 13th April 2025

Time: 5:30 to 8:50 PM

Lectures Days: Tue, Thu, Sat

Lecture Frequency: 3 lectures per week

Mode: Online

Slot 2

Date: 7th April to 27th April 2025

The Refresher Program and Refresher BTest are important as they will carry 20% weightage in the first batch reallocation process for the Foundation Advanced course. For this batch reallocation process, 80% weightage will be given to BTest-1 scheduled on **Sunday, 29th June 2025** and 20% weightage to the Refresher BTest scheduled on **Sunday, 27th April 2025**.

Since, the Refresher Program will be conducted only in Online Mode, the strength of batches in this program may be slightly more than usual.

Details about the Online Camp for students who are not offered the Foundation Advanced course

For students who do not qualify for the Foundation Advanced course, for now, we shall conduct a 3-week **Online Camp** in the month of April 2025. In this online camp, there will be an optimised recap (free of charge) of the Foundation Basic course for Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics subjects followed by a Camp BTest at the end.

Students getting selected after the online camp will be offered only the Champions or COC+Champions batches in the Foundation Advanced course.

Course structure from 5th May (Foundation Advanced batch)

Every 8 weeks, there will be 4 Physics, 4 Chemistry, 4 Maths, 1 Logic, 1 or 2 Coding (alternately) & 4 Biology lectures (optional) each of 3 hours 20 mins duration and 1 BTest of 3 hrs. In addition, separate doubt sessions are also conducted regularly (both online and offline) where a student gets an opportunity to get his/her doubts solved on a one to one basis.

FAQs For Foundation Advanced Course

Q1. What is the duration of Foundation Advanced Course? When does it begin and end? Ans. Foundation Advanced is a 9-month course. Course will begin during the week starting from May 5, 2025 & ends in mid Feb 2026. However, there will be a 'Refresher Program' in the month of March/April 2025.

Q2. What is the deadline for confirming admission in Foundation Advanced course? Ans. For the selected students, the last date to confirm the admission will be 26th January, 2025.

Q3. What about students who do not qualify for the Foundation Advanced course?

Ans. For students who do not qualify for the Foundation Advanced course, for now, we shall conduct a 3-week **Online Camp** in the month of April 2025 (7th April to 27th April 2025). In this online camp, there will be an optimised recap (free of charge) of the Foundation Basic course for Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics subjects followed by a Camp BTest at the end. Students performing well in that test may then be offered the Foundation Advanced course. The online camp will have 6 lectures per week (Monday to Saturday) from 5:30 to 8:50 PM.

If student does not qualify for Foundation Advanced course even after this online camp, we strongly recommend that they repeat the Foundation Basic course and strengthen their fundamentals. The fee for such students who repeat the Foundation Basic course is Rs. 30,000/-.

Q4. What after Foundation Advanced course?

Ans. The students going to 11th standard then should join our 2-year comprehensive course. For the students going to 10th standard then, they are advised to join our 7-month course Foundation Advanced plus. This course will not only keep them in sync with JEE preparation and make them ready for the 2-year Comprehensive course from next year but also shall help them in their 10th boards' preparation.

Q5. We have heard that BT encourages a few outstanding students from 9th/10th std to attend 1 subject out of P/C/M with 11th standard students. Is that true?

Ans. Yes, this course is called the 'Special Comprehensive course'. Many top rankers from BT have benefitted from this concept. Akshay (JEE Adv 2016, AIR 182) & Arnhav Datar (JEE Adv 2018, AIR 200) are few toppers who had benefited from this concept. In fact, all of them except Vedant Talegaonkar cleared Physics Olympiad 1st round as well, with Soham, Vedang, Omkar, Sahil, Arnhav & T.Akshay cleared 2nd round also. Vedang scored a perfect 100 percentile in Physics in JEE Main 2020. Vedang Asgaonkar, Kalpesh Krishna, T. Akshay & Arnhav Datar are toppers at their respective IITs as well.

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
What makes BT different?

1. Unparallelled Genuine Results: Power of BT!

Unlike most institutes which do not even publish their result on their websites and thrive on fake results, we believe in absolute transparency. All the ranks mentioned by us belong to the general category unless otherwise specified clearly. All the results correspond to our classroom students. We have also given contact details of all our IIT-JEE/JEE Advanced qualified students till date, on our website, in the results section. 2. Offline & Online tests with detailed analysis

Offline and Online Tests at BT (called BTests) are thought provoking and bear close resemblance to the actual JEE paper. We analyse the tests from a student's perspective providing detailed and in-depth analytics on time management and test taking strategy. The analytics for the Online test are available immediately after test submission. The analytics of the Offline test are emailed in a couple of days.






