

Apart from his love for studies and students, he also loves music, solving puzzles and playing chess. He has been Rajasthan Under-18 Chess champion and has played in many National level championships.


He was also class representative for his batch, General Secretary for the Mechanical Department and board games secretary for the institute at IIT Bombay.

Vaibhav Sir very deservingly is also the Vice President (Academics) of the Coaching Federation of India (CFI).



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Foundation Advanced Plus course is offered to students who successfully complete Foundation Basic & Advanced course at BT. This course is applicable for student who are currently in 9th standard and pursuing the Foundation Advanced course. Foundation Advanced Plus course helps students gain depth on the concepts of Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Logic & Coding which they have learnt during the Basic & Advanced course. Topics which are relevant for their 10th boards syllabus are also included in the Foundation Advanced Plus course. Therefore, this course not only further develops their confidence but also helps them in their preparation for their 10th board exams.

2 lectures per week shall be offered in this course. Each lecture shall be of 3 hours 20 mins duration, with a 15 mins break in between. In addition to these 2 lectures per week, a few special lectures will also be conducted for **preparation of important exams like Dr. Homi Bhabha, NSEJS and IOQM etc.**

Like in the Foundation Advanced course, Biology subject is an option in the Foundation Advanced Plus course as well. Students can choose Biology as the 6th subject if they wish. Topics covered in Biology will also help them for their 10th boards preparation for Biology.

Students opting for Biology shall have an additional 2 lectures per month.

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Course formats

Foundation Advanced Plus course formats:

The Foundation Advanced Plus course is offered in 2 formats:

- 1. Foundation Advanced Plus Synergy (Offline + Online)
- 2. Foundation Advanced Plus Online (Completely online)

1. Foundation Advanced Plus Synergy:

In this format, every week, 1 lecture shall be conducted in classroom coaching mode at our various centers and 1 lecture shall be conducted in online mode. Online lectures are live lectures as per the batch timing, which the students can attend from the comfort of their homes. For classroom lectures, student can choose a center of his/her choice (out of the options available in this format in his merit-wise category).

2. Foundation Advanced Plus Online:

In this format, students shall attend both lectures per week online. At BT, the online lectures are live and also lively where students participate via chat and by un-muting themselves responsibly.

If students wish, they will be allowed to shift from one format to another at any time during the course, based on seat availability.

Course material & online testing platform

BT provides its own course material and recommends a few books for additional study which the student needs to arrange. It also provides an online testing platform which is used to conduct various practice tests and online BTests. This Online platform provides a detailed & personalised analysis of the student's performance like time spent to solve each question, subject wise comparison with toppers, topic wise strength & weaknesses etc. giving vital inputs for improvement in the examination technique.

Students (residing in Pune) opting for completely online or synergy format will be requested to collect the study material from their nearest BT center in Pune. Students (residing outside Pune) opting for a completely online format will get the study material via courier free of cost (within India). Overseas students will be expected to bear the courier charges.

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Doubt clearing platforms

Apart from doubts discussed during the lecture, there will be various ways through which students can get their doubts cleared. Following are the platforms which students can use for the same:

1. 20 mins reserved for doubts after each lecture:

In addition to the doubts discussed during the lecture, each 3 hour lecture will be followed by a 20 mins doubt session. In these 20 mins, teachers will be available for doubt discussion (both in online and offline lecture). Students can make use of this extra time to interact with teachers personally and get their doubts solved.

2. Availability of teachers for doubts at centers for entire day:

At all centers, teachers dedicated for doubts are available throughout the day where students can discuss their doubts personally with them on a one-to-one basis.

3. Online doubt sessions:

In addition to the regular weekly lectures, we shall also conduct online doubt sessions daily where students can interact with the teacher and get his/her doubts cleared.

4. Doubt Forum:

Bakliwal Tutorials has an interactive doubt forum with exciting features where students can post their doubts and also solve the doubts of other students. Teachers also provide detailed video solutions of the doubts in the forum. The questions are easily searchable and are systematically available for reference and learning. Despite being a closed forum, meant exclusively for BT students, BT's doubt forum is amongst the top results in Google search.

5. Telegram Group:

Official Telegram groups (similar to WhatsApp groups) are created batch-wise with the sole purpose of doubts discussion. Students can post their doubts in that group and fellow batch mates along with teachers will participate to solve the same. This helps students to get instant solutions to most of their doubts at almost any time of the day.

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Online Interaction with students & parents

In order to guide the students and parents about the Foundation Advanced Plus course and answer their queries, the following session is planned for them:

Date - 15th January 2025 (Wednesday)

6:00 to 7:30 pm: Logic revision lecture for students by Vaibhav Bakliwal Sir

7:45 to 9:00 pm: Q & A session for parents & students about the Foundation Advanced Plus course

Admission Process

Admission to the Foundation Advanced Plus course will be based on the student's performance in the 4 BTests conducted during the Foundation Advanced course till date. The following weights will be assigned to each BTest performance:

- **BTest 1** 20% weightage
- **BTest 2** 20% weightage
- **BTest 3 -** 20% weightage
- **BTest 4 -** 40% weightage

In case you were absent for any of these tests, the score for the absent test will be assumed to be the minimum score amongst all the tests for which you were present.

Note that a separate list of students who gave the BTests online and offline will be compiled and the available seats (and scholarships and batches as well) will be split amongst offline and online students in proportion to their total numbers.

Based on merit, only selected Foundation Advanced students will be offered this course. To start with, a few top students will be offered the COC batches and next few sets of students will be offered Champion batches for the Refresher Program.

The students will be informed about their selection for this course, on **16th January 2025** (Thursday) via email. These students need to complete the admission formalities for the Foundation Advanced Plus course latest by **23rd January, 2025** (Thursday). After 23rd January, a few waitlisted students may be offered the admission depending upon the seats availability.

For students who do not qualify for Foundation Advanced Plus course, we strongly recommend that they repeat the Foundation Advanced course and strengthen their fundamentals.

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Start date of the course

The Foundation Advanced Plus course will begin during the week starting from **May 5th**, **2025**.

However, there will be a '**Refresher Program'** in the month of April 2025, the details of which are given below.

Details about the Refresher Program

In this Refresher Program, we shall conduct a quick revision of the Foundation Advanced course for the Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics subjects.

Following are the details of the Refresher Program:

Date : **7th April to 27th April 2025** Time : 5:30 to 8:50 PM Lectures Days : Mon, Wed, Fri Lecture Frequency : 3 lectures per week Lecture Mode : Online

The Refresher Program will be followed by a 3-hour test (Refresher BTest) on **Sunday, 27th April 2025**, for both slots. This test shall be conducted in **offline mode** (for students who want offline/synergy batches) and **online mode** (for students who want completely online batches).

The Refresher Program and Refresher BTest are important as they will carry 20% weightage in the first batch reallocation process for the Foundation Advanced Plus course. For this batch reallocation process, 80% weightage will be given to BTest-1 scheduled on **Sunday, 29th June 2025** and 20% weightage to the Refresher BTest scheduled on **Sunday, 27th April 2025**.

Course structure from 5th May (Foundation Advanced Plus batch)

Every 8 weeks, there will be 4 Physics, 4 Chemistry, 4 Maths, 1 Logic, 1 or 2 Coding (alternately) & 4 Biology lectures (optional) each of 3 hours 20 mins duration and 1 BTest of 3 hrs. In addition, separate doubt sessions are also conducted regularly (both online and offline) where a student gets an opportunity to get his/her doubts solved on a one to one basis.

Rs. 14,000	For students getting Bronze Medal in the exam
Rs. 10,000	For students clearing Stage I - Theory Competition in the exam

Note :

- No student can avail more than one scholarship. In case a student is qualifying for multiple criteria, which ever criteria has the higher amount will be awarded to the student.
- All the above scholarships are applicable for the achievements after April 2023 till the beginning of the course (May 2025).
- Students who do not enroll within the mentioned timeline (23rd January 2025) shall not be entitled for any scholarship.

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Q1.What is the duration of Foundation Advanced Plus Course? When does it begin and end?

Ans. Foundation Advanced Plus is a 7.5-month course which will begin during the week starting from May 5th, 2025 & shall end by mid - Dec 2025. However, there will be a '**Refresher Program**' in the month of April 2025.

Q2. What about students who do not qualify for the Foundation Advanced Plus course?

Ans. For students who do not qualify for Foundation Advanced Plus course, we strongly recommend that they repeat the Foundation Advanced course and strengthen their fundamentals. Fee for students who repeat the Foundation Advanced course is **Rs. 30,000**/.

Q3. What after the completion of Foundation Advanced Plus course?

Ans. After successful completion of the Foundation Advanced Plus course, students are eligible to join our 2-year Comprehensive course, for which a separate entrance exam shall be conducted.

Q4. Would Foundation Advanced Plus course overburden the student as he has to prepare for his 10th standard board exam also this year?

Ans. Objective of this course is to keep the student in sync with the JEE preparation and ensure their steady progress for the same. Hence, any break in between is not desirable. We have kept the duration of this course short (only 7.5 months) and would be ending this course in mid - Dec itself so that the student gets free early for his board exam preparation. Hence, this course in no way would overburden the student. On the contrary, most topics from this course shall only help students for their 10th boards preparation.

Q5. We have heard that BT encourages a few outstanding students from 9th/10th std to attend 1 subject out of P/C/M with 11th standard students. Is that true?

Ans. Yes, this course is called the 'Special Comprehensive course'. Many top rankers from BT have benefitted from this concept. For example, Vedang Asgaonkar (JEE Adv 2020, AIR 7), Omkar Thakoor (IIT-JEE 2010, AIR 11), AIR 39), Soham Joshi (JEE Adv 2021, AIR 46), Vedant Talegaonkar (JEE Adv 2022, AIR 89), Kalpesh Krishna (JEE Adv 2014, AIR 93), Shlok Pande (JEE Adv 2021, AIR 94), Shubhranil C.(JEE Adv 2021, AIR 157), Sahil Agrawal (IITJEE 2010, AIR 176), T. Akshay (JEE Adv 2016, AIR 182) & Arnhav Datar (JEE Adv 2018, AIR 200) are few toppers who had benefited from this concept. In fact, all of them except Vedant Talegaonkar cleared Physics Olympiad 1st round as well, with Soham, Vedang, Omkar, Sahil, Arnhav & T.Akshay cleared 2nd round also. Vedang scored a perfect 100 percentile in Physics in JEE Main 2020. Vedang Asgaonkar, Kalpesh Krishna, T. Akshay & Arnhav Datar are toppers at their respective IITs as well.


What makes BT different?

1. Unparallelled Genuine Results: Power of BT!

Unlike most institutes which do not even publish their result on their websites and thrive on fake results, we believe in absolute transparency. All the ranks mentioned by us belong to the general category unless otherwise specified clearly. All the results correspond to our classroom students. We have also given contact details of all our IIT-JEE/JEE Advanced qualified students till date, on our website, in the results section. We are yet to come across an institute in entire India which has the honesty, courage & confidence of declaring their results, consistently year after year, in such a transparent manner.

2. Offline & Online tests with detailed analysis

Offline and Online Tests at BT (called BTests) are thought provoking and bear close resemblance to the actual JEE paper. We analyse the tests from a student's perspective providing detailed and in-depth analytics on time management and test taking strategy. The analytics for the Online test are available immediately after test submission. The analytics of the Offline test are emailed in a couple of days.



Some of the parameters on which students' performance is analysed are mentioned below:

- **Subject Analysis**: Students get to know their performance in each subject along with time spent per subject per question.
- **SWOT Analysis:** Students can clearly see the topics in which they are strong or weak and then can easily decide the time to be spent on each topic going forward.
- Analysis as per question type: Questions in each test are tagged as per various types (single option correct, multiple options correct, integer type etc.) and students get to know how they fared under each type giving them an understanding of where they need to improve.
- Attempt Analysis: A unique analysis of questions attempted by the students' according to their difficulty level is provided to the students' to give an understanding of whether the easier questions were attempted earlier than the difficult questions or not.

Merit based batches is one of the attributes that is common across all the successful JEE institutes across the country. It is a proven fact that when students study with peers of relatively same intelligence level, they are able to learn more and even the teachers are able to plan their lectures well. 4. Focus on Boards & MHT-CET as well

We at BT teach the basic concepts so well that the student understands the subject to the core and then it is just a matter of a little bit of tuning according to the different exams. 5. Well Equipped Classrooms, Study Room & Library Facility

BT offers state of the art infrastructure at each of their centre with spacious, AC ventilated classrooms having Digital Boards. In addition to the classrooms, separate study rooms are maintained which are dedicated for students for their self study. Students can also make use of the various reference books available in the library.

6. Counseling Session after JEE Advanced Result

A detailed counseling session is conducted for all the students after their JEE and other exam results are declared. In this session, along with the teachers, senior students from BT, who have joined various IITs and other top colleges like NIT's, BITS etc. participate and guide the passing out batch on the right options to choose as per their merit and interest.

7. Student Mentorship Program

Each and every student at BT is assigned a personal Mentor. These mentors are young trainee teachers at BT, who have recently passed out from top colleges like IIT/NIT etc. Mentor keeps meeting the student at regular intervals, discusses student's academic activities in detail including the daily study routine. The mentor also keeps a check of the progress of the student and connects with the parent to discuss the same. 
