About NSE: The Science and Astronomy Olympiad Programme in India has five stages. It starts with the **NSE**, a national-level exam held in November. Top scorers qualify for the **INO** in January, followed by selection for the **OCSC** at HBCSE (Mumbai), where students receive advanced training. Final team members attend a **Pre-Departure Camp** before competing in the **International Olympiads**, where Indian students often win medals.

The Indian Mathematical Olympiad Programme, conducted by HBCSE on behalf of NBHM (DAE, Government of India), aims to identify mathematical talent among pre-university students. It has five stages: IOQM, a 3-hour objective exam; RMO, a 3-hour descriptive test; INMO, held nationwide for top RMO qualifiers; IMOTC, a training and selection camp at HBCSE for 65 students; and finally a Pre-Departure Camp, after which six students are selected to represent India at the International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO).

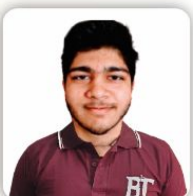

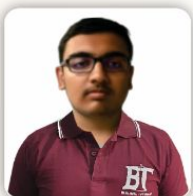

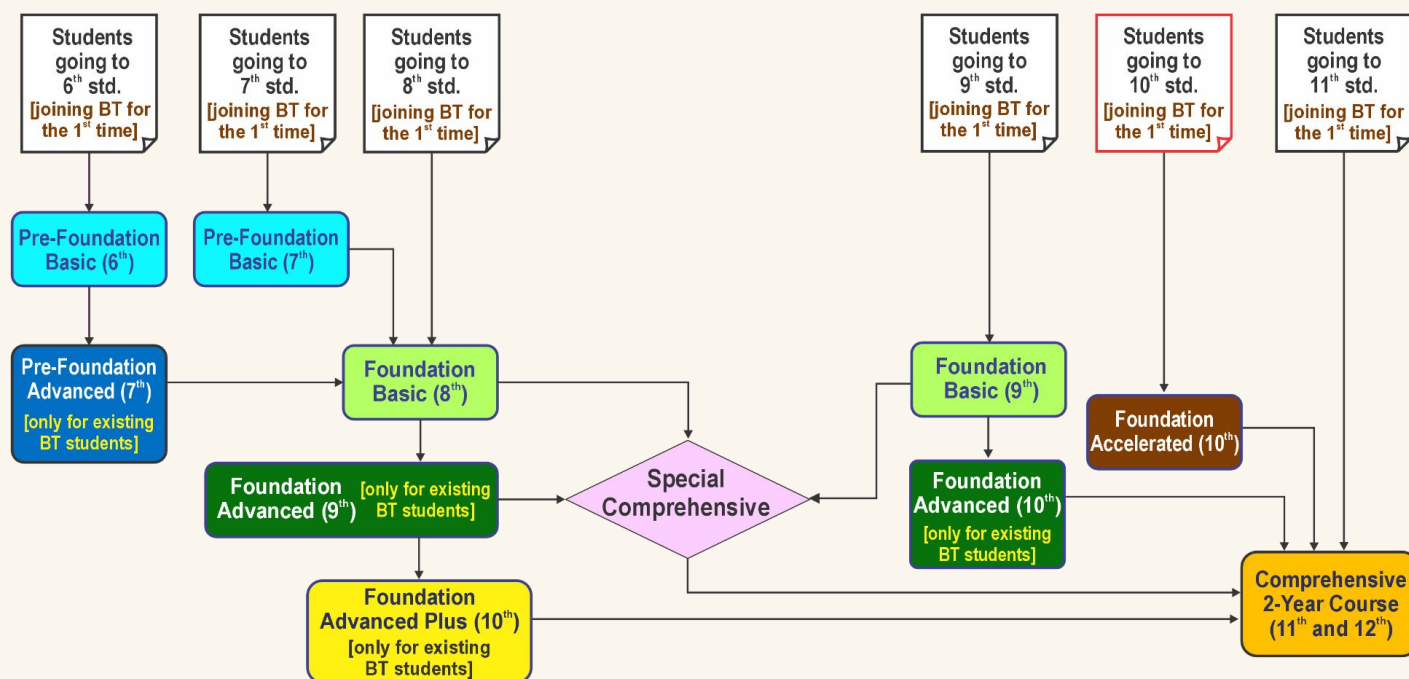

About Foundation Accelerated Course

Course details

The **Foundation Accelerated course** at BT is carefully designed to help students excel in quality competitive exams. The **Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics** lectures, along with well-planned study material, aim to build strong conceptual understanding and early interest in these subjects. **Logic** lectures further enhance analytical thinking and problem-solving abilities, while **Biology** lectures support students in strengthening their Class 10 board preparation. The course includes **2 lectures per week**, each of **3 hours and 30 minutes**, complemented by special sessions focused on competitive exams and multiple doubt-clearing sessions.

To ensure consistent learning, students attempt a **30-minute online Practice Test** after every lecture to evaluate their understanding. A **3-hour Pre-BTest practice exam** is conducted a few days before each BTest to build confidence, followed by a **comprehensive 3-hour BTest every 8 weeks**, which determines batch shuffling and progression to the next level. **Overall, this course is thoughtfully crafted to strengthen students' thinking abilities and provide them with a realistic experience of competitive examinations.**

Students who are currently in 10th standard and wish to join BT at this stage will begin their classes along with the Class 8th and 9th students (Foundation Basic, as the initial portion of the syllabus is common in both courses. The batch will commence on Tuesday, 30th June. Classes will be conducted in a completely Online mode, with 3 to 4 lectures per week (alternating), each lecture being 3 hours 30 minutes in duration. This batch will continue separately until the 2nd Common BTest scheduled on 30th August, after which it will be merged with the Foundation Accelerated batches that commenced in May, once the course coverage of both batches is synchronized. Thereafter, students will attend two lectures per week and will be allotted a batch based on their preference and performance (merit). Further details regarding the available batches are provided in the subsequent sections.

Course formats (after 30th August)

The Foundation Basic course is offered in 3 formats:

1. Foundation Basic Offline (Completely Offline)
2. Foundation Basic Synergy (Offline + Online)
3. Foundation Basic Online (Completely Online)

1. Foundation Basic Offline:

In this format, both the lectures per week will be conducted in classroom coaching mode (offline mode). The student can choose a center of his/her choice (out of the options available in this format in his/her merit-wise category).

2. Foundation Basic Synergy:

In this format, every week, 1 lecture will be conducted in classroom coaching mode and 1 lecture will be conducted in online mode. Online lectures are live lectures as per the batch timing, which the students can attend from the comfort of their homes. For classroom lectures, the student can choose a center of his/her choice (out of the options available in this format in his merit-wise category).

3. Foundation Basic Online:

In this format, both the lectures per week will be conducted in online mode. At BT, the online lectures are live and also lively where students participate via chat and by un-muting themselves responsibly.

About Foundation Basic Course

Course material & Online testing platform

BT provides its own course material and recommends a few books for additional study which the student needs to arrange. It also provides an online testing platform which is used to conduct various practice tests and online BTests. This Online platform provides a detailed & personalised analysis of the student's performance like time spent to solve each question, subject wise comparison with toppers, topic wise strength & weaknesses etc. giving vital inputs for improvement in the examination technique.

Students opting for Completely offline or synergy format will be requested to collect the study material from their nearest BT center in Pune. Students opting for a completely online format will get the study material via courier free of cost (within India). Overseas students will be expected to bear the courier charges.

Doubt clearing platforms

Apart from doubts discussed during the lecture, there will be various ways through which students can get their doubts cleared. Following are the platforms which students can use for the same:

1. Doubts during breaks or after each lecture:

Students can utilize break time (15 mins) or the period after lecture (15 mins) to engage with teachers individually and clarify their doubts.

2. Availability of teachers for doubts at centers for entire day:

At all centers, teachers dedicated for doubts are available throughout the day where students can discuss their doubts personally with them on a one-to-one basis.

3. Online doubt sessions:

Types of Batches (after 30th August)

Getting the best students together is one of the attributes that is common across all the top rank producing institutes in the country. The concept of 'merit wise batches' allows students to study with their peers of relatively similar preparedness. This maximizes the personal growth of students and even the teachers are able to plan their lectures well. This also creates a spirit of positive & healthy competition among the students.

Types of Batches: In the Foundation Accelerated course, there are 2 types of batches.

1. **Champions of Champions (COC)** - Students who perform very well in the entrance exam are selected for the COC batch.
2. **Champions** - The next set of students who perform well get selected for the Champion batch.

Students who do not perform even up to a bare minimum level are not offered admission.

To begin with, students will be allotted batches as per their performance in the entrance exam. In the Foundation Accelerated course, after every 8 weeks, we conduct a BTest. Based on the performance in this BTest, batches shall be re-allotted to students after BTest-1 & BTest-3 on merit.

Course structure (after 30th August)

The Foundation Basic course follows an 8 weeks cycle during which 4 Physics, 4 Mathematics, 4 Chemistry, 1 or 2 Coding & 1 Logic lectures are conducted. On the Sunday of every 8th week, a 3 hour test is conducted which is called BTest. Depending upon the performance in BTests, batches are shuffled after BTest-1 and BTest-3 on merit.

Biology lectures (optional) are conducted twice in a month.

Selection process for the Foundation Accelerated course

Selection for the Foundation Accelerated course (**Batch starting from 30th June**) will be based on the performance in the On-Spot entrance exam.

Online Entrance Exam Date : On-Spot (IQ based test)

1. The On-Spot Entrance Exam will be conducted in either Offline (at selected centres) or AI-Proctored Online mode. If the student registers for the On-Spot Entrance Exam before 1.00 pm then he/she can appear on same day else have to appear for the On-Spot Entrance Exam the next day at 4.00pm.

These scholarships are awarded based on the combined performance of the students in the first 4 BTests (aggregate) that will be conducted in this course. The list of these top 20 students shall be declared after the 4th BTest. They shall be refunded the applicable amount then.

Rs. 16,000	For students with a rank in top 10
Rs. 10,000	For students with a rank from 11 to 20

In case a student has already availed any other scholarship at the time of admission process and has qualified for this scholarship as well, higher of the 2 amount shall be applicable for him/her. Also, based on the same criteria, additional scholarship shall be offered for the next course as well.

Note :

- No student can avail more than one scholarship. In case a student is qualifying for multiple criteria, which ever criteria has the higher amount will be awarded to the student.
- All the above scholarships are applicable for the achievements after April 2024 till the beginning of the course (May 2026).
- Students who do not enroll (within a week from the day of BT's entrance exam result declaration) would not be entitled for any scholarship.
- The scholarship amount shall be adjusted in the second installment.

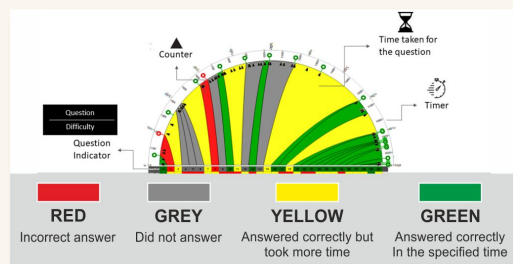

1. Unparalleled Genuine Results: Power of BT!

Unlike most institutes which do not even publish their result on their websites and thrive on fake results, we believe in absolute transparency. All the ranks mentioned by us belong to the general category unless otherwise specified clearly. All the results correspond to our classroom students. We have also given contact details of all our IIT-JEE/JEE Advanced qualified students till date, on our website, in the results section. 2. Offline & Online tests with detailed analysis

Offline and Online Tests at BT (called BTests) are thought provoking and bear close resemblance to the actual JEE paper. We analyse the tests from a student's perspective providing detailed and in-depth analytics on time management and test taking strategy. The analytics for the Online test are available immediately after test submission. The analytics of the Offline test are emailed in a couple of days.

5. Well Equipped Classrooms, Study Room & Library Facility

BT offers state of the art infrastructure at each of their centre with spacious, AC ventilated classrooms having Digital Boards. 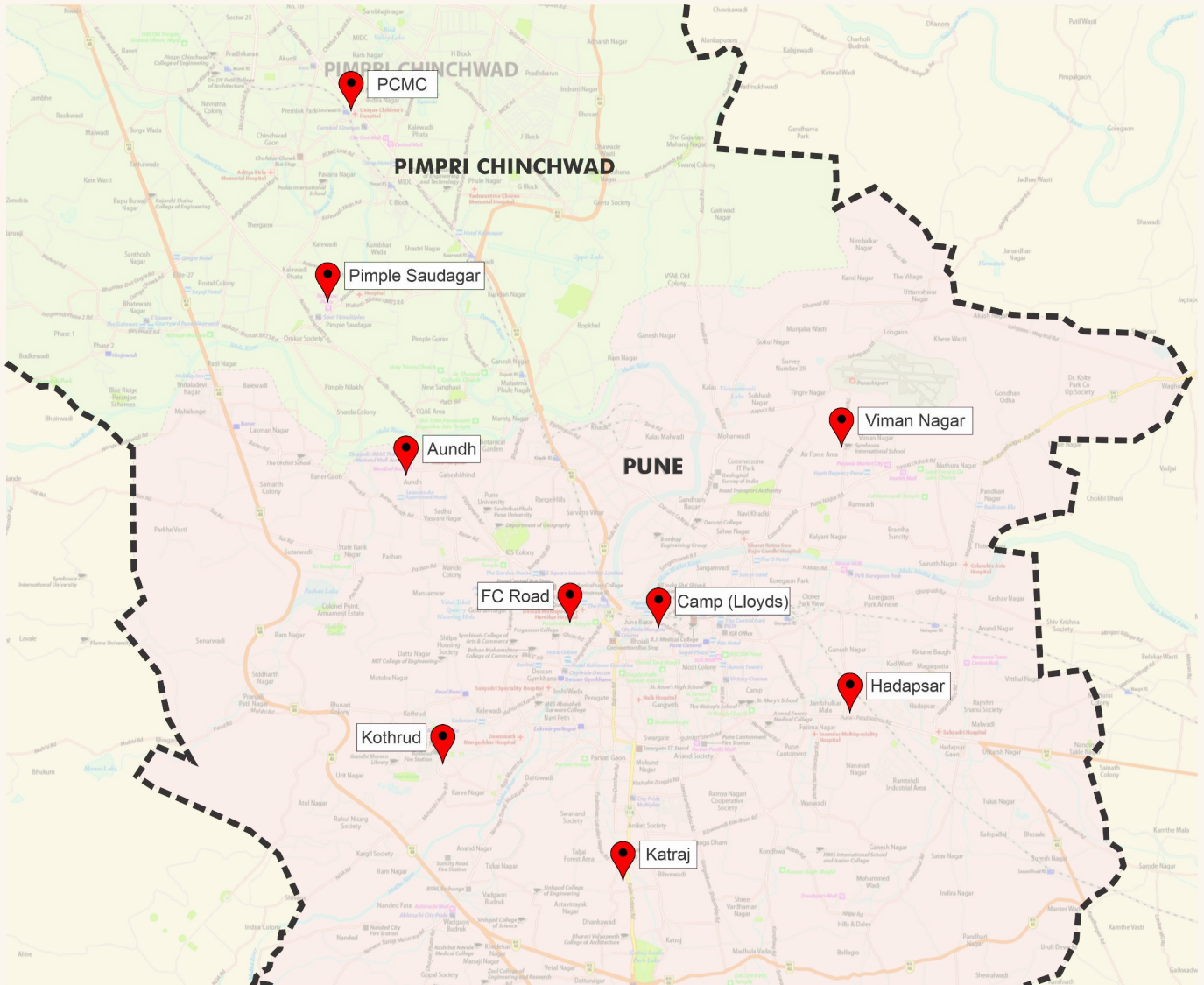
